

School Performance

There have been many changes in last few years at Sandy Lane. This year we have been able to have a more settled staff leading to improved teaching & learning for your children across the school. We have been successful in many wider areas (including sports successes, attending events, representing our community) but we have also had a major improvement in our academic results across the school bringing our achievement in line with or above National and Bracknell Forest data. The information below is reported data this year which doesn't involve all year groups but this improved performance is being reflected across the school.

HEADLINES SAT RESULTS 2018:

FS: 72% achieving Good Level of Development (expected standard); **a 27% increase** on 2017 and in line with national average

Year 1 Phonics: 90% achieving pass; **19% increase** on 2017 and above National and Bracknell Forest average

KS1 (Year 2) (National data currently available)

Reading – 71% of pupils achieving expected standard is **7% higher** than 2017 and in-line with National and LA

Writing - 73% of pupils achieving expected standard is **23% higher** than 2017 and in-line with National and LA

Maths - 72% of pupils achieving expected standard is **14% higher** than 2017 and in-line with National and LA

Reading, Writing & Maths combined - 64% of pupils achieving expected standard is 19% higher than 2017 and in-line with National and LA

KS2 (Year 6) against LA & National

Reading – 79% of pupils achieving expected standard is **12% higher** than 2017; and in-line with National and LA

Writing - 72% of pupils achieving expected standard is **25% higher** than 2017; and in-line with National and LA

Maths - 77% of pupils achieving expected standard is **20% higher** than 2017 and in-line with National and LA

SPAG – 76% of pupils achieving expected standard is **10% higher** than 2017 and in-line with National and LA

Reading, Writing & Maths combined - 64% achieving expected standard is 27% higher than 2017; and in-line with National and LA
